Discussion/Possible Action-New Hire Preference Points

DC Kurka spoke on the application process for FFPM. The testing process will be done through College of DuPage. Applications are available until the end of July and virtual orientation in August with

requirements the same as previous years except the CPAT/Ladder requirement has been changed due to COVID and certificate now due at time of hire.

DC Kurka spoke on preference points for current POC's. After discussion, the board will reward .5 point per year of service as POC. The board will also offer 5 points to Bloomingdale Fire District residents.
