BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS MEETING  
November 17, 2016

Meeting called to order by Chairman Gray at 3:00 P.M.

CHIEFS REPORT:

Chief Janus reported that the district responded to 357 calls in October, averaging 11.5 calls per shift. The Chief remarked on significant calls for the month which included two water rescues.

Chief remarked on special events during the month: we attended the Family Health & Safety Fair in Glendale Heights, we hosted our annual open house, and we assisted with a fundraiser at Jasper Meats for the 100 Club.

Chief Janus provided a brief overview of the training that was completed: crews completed SCBA consumption testing. Crews logged over 938 hours of training in October.

The Chief shared that two citizens and three Glendale Heights Police Officers were recognized for their efforts in regards to a citizen in distress. Also, for a separate incident, three Bloomingdale Police Officers were also recognized for their assistance on a call.

The Chief recognized DC Kaderabek and FF/PM Skelley for their efforts preparing for the SCBA evaluation process.

Chief Janus provided a brief overview of fire prevention: fire prevention has been very busy working with Stratford Square, Indian Lakes and Mariano's. Fire Marshal Kostal also gave a senior safety talk at Bloomingdale Township and received many accolades.
